Shape the Strategy and Measure the Impact

- Proactively shape the future growth strategy of the Foundation
- Manage small team to deliver the plan and strategy
- Measure overall impact and progress against strategy with the support of the team and reporting to Trustees
- Produce an annual impact report to demonstrate achievements of the charity
- Create reports for grant makers, donors and the Charity Commission as needed
- Oversee annual budget and plan for future by creating 3-year view of financial position
